## I AM TAKING A STAND FOR CHILDREN IN NEED IN BUCKS COUNTY.

1 in 10 children suffer from child maltreatment. The youngest children are the most vulnerable. More than 45% of abused children are under the age of 5.

Family Service helps prevent child abuse by providing in-home parent education and support.

More than 350 Bucks County children live in foster homes.

Family Service works to reunify parents with their children who are in foster care.

Fewer than 20% of children and teens with mental health problems receive the treatment they need.

Family Service eliminates many barriers that can prevent families from accessing mental health services for children and youth by providing counseling services directly in the school environment.

Approximately 500 people are homeless in Bucks County, and about 40% of those are children.

Family Service provides emergency shelter for families who have lost safe, stable housing.
