EVERY FAMILY DESERVES A HOME.

The Family Service Emergency Homeless Shelter is a temporary residence for individuals and families who have lost safe and stable housing. The shelter operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and accommodates approximately 75 people at any given time. Typically, about a third of the residents are children.

On-site services for shelter residents include case management, job search and preparation, budget planning, health evaluations and referrals, outpatient counseling, and transportation.

The shelter has a large dorm area for women and children, a moderate-sized dorm area for men, three private family units, and two modular homes on the property. Its variety of spaces enables the shelter to accommodate families of all different sizes and compositions, keeping residents safe and secure as they battle through one of the most difficult periods of their lives.

The shelter is an important step as families work to find their way home again. Contributions from generous donors and the incredible effort put forth by hundreds of hard-working volunteers each year are the driving force behind the shelter's sustainability.
